During workshops, students are checked for basic and advanced technique in the areas of snare drum tech and marching. All students who wish to play stand still percussion (Mallets & Perc) or marching percussion (Bass, Snare, tenors, etc) will need to attend both sessions.

If you play piano already you can play mallet instruments! **Students will be pulled out of the workshops to have a brief interview on Thursday May 26th.**
