During workshops, students are checked for basic and advanced technique in the areas of snare drum tech and marching. Open spots are; Marimbas, Xylophone, Bells, Vibraphones, Snare Drum, Bass Drum, Tenor Drums, and Drum Set. It is important that all students be open to more than one instrument when trying out instruments. Please notify us if you play a wind instrument. **This year Front Ensemble (standstill performers) placements and Battery (marchers) placements will be on 2 different sessions.**

Attendance at either session is mandatory to be considered. Middle school students need to learn the technique, style, and skills to be successful for marching and stand-still percussion. Returning members need to be there for practice and review.

Clinics are designed to teach you basic techniques you will need to be successful during the placements. Beginners that are attentive will be successful during this process. If you play piano already you can play mallet instrument! **Students will be pulled out of the workshops to have a brief interview on the day of the placements. Students are more than welcomed to attend BOTH sessions!!!**

**Note:**

There is NO audition required for Concert Band (1<sup>st</sup> period) percussion students. Students wishing to participate with the Triton Marching Alliance drum line, however, **MUST** audition and be enrolled in a music class.
